This is a community-based sanction imposed by a Judge as an alternative to a prison sentence of 12 months or less for persons aged . The Introduction of Community Service Orders: Mapping its . (1) Instead of imposing a sentence of imprisonment on an offender, a court may make a community service order directing the offender to perform community service work for a specified number of hours.
